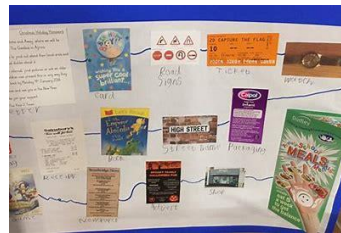
Re: Summer Holiday Projects

Can you read the length of the river? Anything you read from train tickets, leaflets from places you visit, postcards, receipts, signs to books fill the river with everything you read this summer.

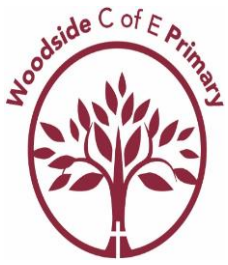
All children who complete the reading river will receive a certificate and small prize. There will be one reading river per class for the child who completes the river and reads a variety of materials.

We are encouraging each child to create a 'Book in a Jar'.

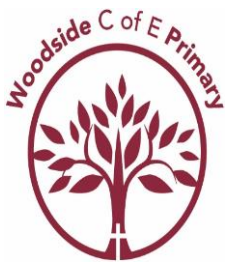
