Music Plus Trust will be working with **all KS2 children- Y3-Y6** on a very exciting and important project linking in with our **'anti bullying week'- 'Will you 'like' me?'**. **The project looks at the online world and ways in which it impacts on our children, and their families. Recently, the Children's Commissioner highlighted the importance of helping our children learn about these issues and we believe this is a key aspect of life and growing up in our community today.** 'Music Plus Trust' is an educational charity directed by Andy Silver founder of the 'PopUK' project, which empowers children with messages about key life skills and values that are important in modern life.
