1.00-1.10 Calm Me time

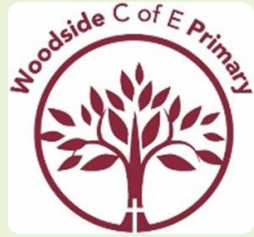
1.10-1.25 Whole class time

Your child can bring in a lunchbox if they prefer this to a school dinner



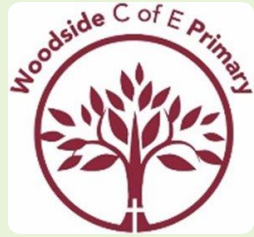
Milk is free until your child is 5. Order via [schoolmilk.com](http://schoolmilk.com)

# Absences and holidays

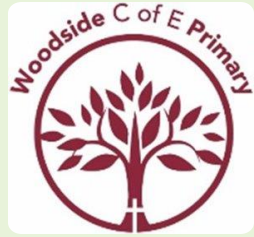


Please phone school every day your child is absent

Inhalers/epi-pens must be in date and a form filled in.

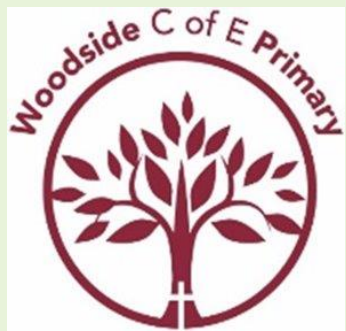
Medicine can be given but a medical form must be filled in and the medicine given directly to the office.

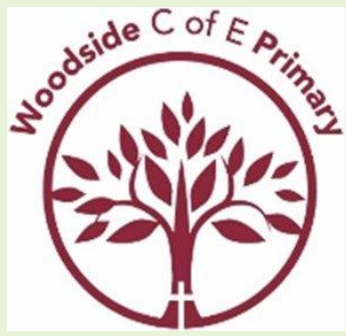

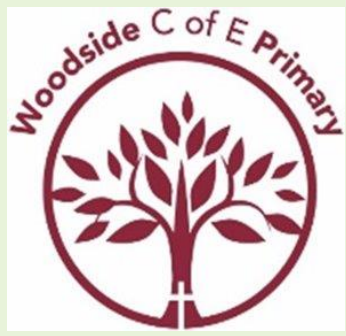


# Change of clothes

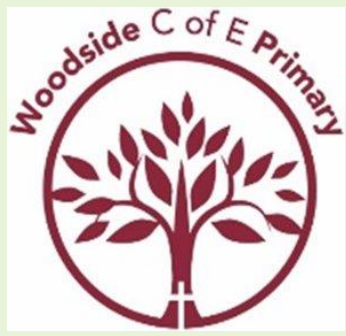

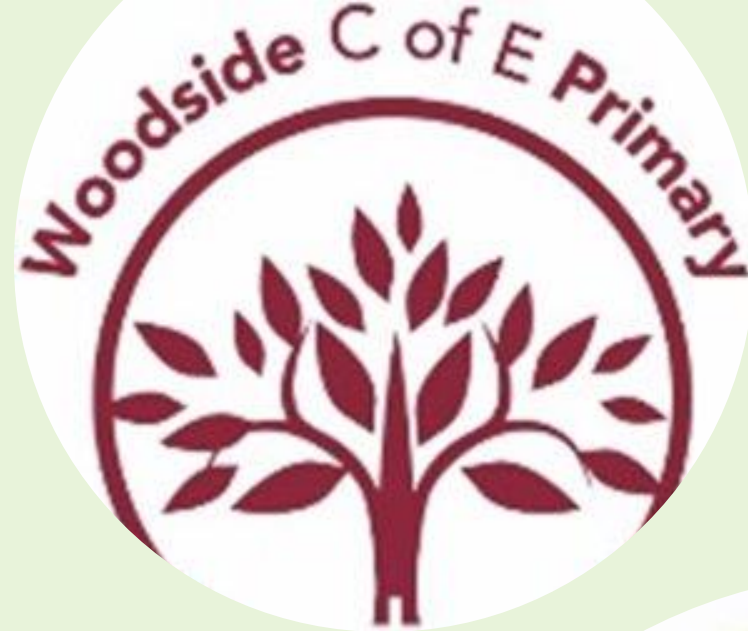
