How to create a 'Reading River'

Reading rivers can include lots of different forms of reading. Including: books, magazines, schoolwork, letters, newspaper, or even a signpost!

How to create your own:

- Take note of every time you read something, even if it is really small!
- You can use pictures/drawings/words to represent your reading (see pictures).
- You can then draw out your reading journey of the day! Use lots of colour and pictures!





By doing this, we can recognise how much reading we do throughout the day both in school and outside of school.

To represent your reading journey, you could use:

- Arrows
- A river
- Lines

In order to make sure you remember every time you read something, carry around a little notebook/piece of paper and write down what you have read from!
