

Motte and Bailey- used by the Saxons. Built on hills or mounds to survey the area and give advantage to defenders.

Stone Keep- First one in England was the Tower of London built by William the Conqueror in 1078. Used because they couldn't be burned down.

Palaces- Inventions like gunpowder and trebuchets meant castles were no longer used for defence. Plus, England didn't have as many wars. Castles became homes for the rich.
